What do you wish every classmate knew about Jesus?



THE E.P.I.C. STRATEGY

The E.P.I.C. Cycle is a 4-week plan with a new topic every month:

Invite Weeks try to meet during lunch hours, and other weeks meet during your regular club time.

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WEEK 2 CONTINUED... HOW?



IS A WEEKLY CLUB FOR DAILY IMPACT.

RESPONDING TO CHRIST

1. At the **beginning** of every Invite Week, **greeters** at the door can hand out this attendance cards to **every** student.

2. After the message, your **Speaker** or **Host** can say something similar to:

"Jesus loves you and gave His life for you, and right now you have the chance to respond in faith to Him. Please fill out your attendance card and pass it forward so we can help you take a next step of faith."

3. **Collect Attendance Cards** before closing in prayer.

4. After club, have your Campus Coach **take a picture** of the cards, and **hand out the cards** for follow up to the students who are listed under "Who Invited You".

ATTENDANCE CARD

Check at *least one* and turn in at the end of club.

- I need repentance and prayer.
- I want a church/youth group to attend.
- I have questions about the Gospel.
- I want to be a student leader.

EACH ATTENDANCE CARD IS YOUR FRIEND'S WAY OF ASKING YOU TO TEACH THEM MORE ABOUT JESUS!

FOLLOW UP

- **If a student marks any of the first four boxes (highlighted above)**, help them respond with faith in Jesus!
- **Notice** how each card asks "Who Invited You?". If your name is on an Attendance Card for a student who marked a decision, **it is your job to follow up with them by using the Next Steps on the back of the Attendance Card.**
- At **Connect Week** the week after, you can connect them more to Christ, your church, and your club.

CLUB KITS

Every student on their first club visit can receive a free First Priority bag with a bunch of freebies that will help them become regular club members! **Campus Coaches** will have extra resources such as Bibles, Free Shirts, and Curriculum.

WEEK 3

PLAN

Today, you will plan the first month of the E.P.I.C. Cycle!

PLAN [10-12 MINUTES]

OPEN UP YOUR CURRICULUM

Open up the first month of the EPIC Purpose Curriculum. This is simply a guide, not a word-for-word script you have to say.



Break into 4 groups, one for each week of the E.P.I.C. Cycle:

1. Read through your assigned week.
2. Find 3 volunteers for the 3 leadership tasks each week: *Welcoming, Teaching, and Challenging*.
3. Every role needs preparation, so **plan on checking in** once a week as a club on Mondays to see if everyone is ready!

**Your Campus Coach will have a paper curriculum to use.*

PRESENT [10 MINUTES]

Have each group share about what's planned for their week in a 1-2 minutes!

As you discover how to plan a week of FP, this is a great time to ask your Campus Coach and Teacher Sponsor questions or advice!

SCHEDULE YOUR PLAN WEEKS

Choose to either plan monthly outside of your normal club time, or plan every week for the next E.P.I.C. week after club ends.

PRAY
